HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every choice aloud and pause so children can make their own marks. Children identify Independence Day by its date, the country it honors, and a common celebration tradition, then trace the date.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE CLUES

SAY "Listen to each question and look at the big choices in that row. Circle one choice for each question."

b	Listen as I read USA, Canada, and Mexico. Which name is our country on Independence Day?	USA
