HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Display a clear American flag and a clear Virginia flag where students can see them. Read the clues and choices aloud, and let students look back at the flags before they mark their answers.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Look closely at the two flags. I will read a clue and the three flag names in each row. Which name matches the clue? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which flag has stars and stripes: Virginia, American, or Canada? Circle it.	American
b	Which flag has a blue field with Virginia's state seal: American, Canada, or Virginia? Circle it.	Virginia
c	Which flag has red and white stripes and a blue part with stars: American, Virginia, or Canada? Circle it.	American

PART 2 • MATCH CLUES

SAY “I will read each flag name and each clue word. Draw a line from each flag name to the clue word that belongs with it.”

- **American** matches **Stars**
- **Virginia** matches **Seal**
- **American** matches **Stripes**

Circle-row answers are American, Virginia, and American. Match American to Stars, Virginia to Seal, and American to Stripes.
