HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "I will read the words in each row. Listen to the question, then circle one word."

b	These words say voters, president, and teacher. Who is the leader of the United States?	President
c	These words say leader, teacher, and voters. Who elects, or chooses, the president?	Voters
