HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every choice aloud and give students time to circle or draw each line. Students show patriotism knowledge by naming ways communities show respect for the United States, recognizing the Pledge of Allegiance and the national anthem orally, and identifying flags, symbols, and the president.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE NAMES

SAY "Patriotism means love and respect for your country. What is one way a community can show patriotism together? I will read the choices in each row, then you will circle your answer. What is the name of the promise that begins, "I pledge allegiance"? What do we call our country's special song?"

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle answers are American, Virginia, and Trump. Match Bald to Eagle, Dogwood to Flower, and Cardinal to Bird. Accept oral responses that define patriotism as love or respect for one's country, name a community action such as flying flags, saying the Pledge, or singing the national anthem, identify the Pledge of Allegiance and national anthem, and state that voters elect the president.
