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HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to mark the shapes. Students show that they can sort figures by noticing curved edges, straight sides, and corners.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Look at the shapes in each row. Listen to my question, then circle one shape.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which shape has a curved edge and no corners? Circle it.	circle
b	Which shape has 3 sides and 3 corners? Circle it.	triangle
c	Which shape has 5 sides and 5 corners? Circle it.	pentagon

PART 2 • MATCH SIDES

SAY “Look at each shape on the left and the dot groups on the right. Draw a line from each shape to the dots that show how many sides the shape has.”

- **triangle** matches **3 dots**
- **square** matches **4 dots**
- **pentagon** matches **5 dots**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle rows: circle, triangle, pentagon. In Match Sides, connect triangle to 3 dots, square to 4 dots, and pentagon to 5 dots.
