**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to look at the large choices before marking. Students show this skill by naming right angles orally, finding shapes with four right angles, and tracing the word right beside squares and rectangles.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CIRCLE IT**

**SAY** “Listen to each question and the choices. Circle one answer in every row.”

**SAY** “Look at each shape beside a box. What kind of angles does it have? Trace the gray word in each box.”

- Box 1 (beside square): **right**
- Box 2 (beside rectangle): **right**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Circle answers are right, square, and rectangle. Accept an oral response of right angle or right angles for each tracing box, and accept a reasonably traced or copied right.
