HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

On an analog clock, at 8:00 the hour hand is on 8. At 10:30, the hour hand is between 10 and 11. Read each prompt aloud, then have students mark their answers.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • WHERE IS IT

SAY “Listen to each clock time and the three location words. Which word tells where the hour hand is?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A clock says 6:00. Is the hour hand between, on, or next to a number? Circle the word that tells where it is.	on
b	A clock says 1:30. Is the hour hand on, next to, or between numbers? Circle the word that tells where it is.	between
c	A clock says 9:00. Is the hour hand on, between, or next to a number? Circle the word that tells where it is.	on

PART 2 • WRITE NEXT

SAY “Look at each time beside a box. At a half-hour time, the hour hand is between the hour shown and the next number. What is the next number? Write it in the matching box.”

- Box 1 (beside 3:30): **4**
- Box 2 (beside 7:30): **8**
- Box 3 (beside 11:30): **12**

Part 1 answers are on, between, on. Part 2 answers are 4, 8, and 12. Accept correctly formed numerals or clearly recognizable numeral attempts.
