HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to think before they mark. Students use dates in order to find a date before or after today and to count forward or backward by several days.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each date question. In each row, I will read the numbers. Circle the date that answers the question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Today is the 8th. What date was yesterday? Is it 7, 8, or 9? Circle the date.	7
b	Today is the 15th. What date will it be tomorrow? Is it 14, 16, or 17? Circle the date.	16
c	Today is the 20th. What date will it be in 4 days? Is it 23, 24, or 25? Circle the date.	24

PART 2 • WRITE DATES

SAY “Look at the number beside each box. For the first box, today is the 11th. What date was yesterday? Write the number. For the second box, today is the 9th. What date will it be in 2 days? Write the number. For the third box, today is the 25th. What date was it 3 days ago? Write the number.”

- Box 1 (beside 11): **10**
- Box 2 (beside 9): **11**
- Box 3 (beside 25): **22**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are 7, 16, and 24. Accept clearly written numerals 10, 11, and 22 in the boxes.
