HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each set amount aloud slowly, repeating the three numbers if needed. Students listen for which amount is least, middle, and greatest, then write the numerals in the labeled boxes. The first part orders upward, and the second part orders downward.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SMALL TO BIG

SAY “I will name how many objects are in three sets: 76, 119, and 83. Which number belongs in the Least box, which belongs in the Middle box, and which belongs in the Greatest box? Write each number in a box.”

- Box 1 (beside Least): **76**
- Box 2 (beside Middle): **83**
- Box 3 (beside Greatest): **119**

PART 2 • BIG TO SMALL

SAY “I will name how many objects are in three sets: 120, 64, and 105. Which number belongs in the Greatest box, which belongs in the Middle box, and which belongs in the Least box? Write each number in a box.”

- Box 1 (beside Greatest): **120**
- Box 2 (beside Middle): **105**
- Box 3 (beside Least): **64**
