**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read the color survey table aloud. Each dot stands for one vote, and the students circle the numeral that matches each row. Then have students use the same dot data to write three answers about the survey.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • COUNT DOTS**

**SAY** “We asked children to pick a color. Each dot is one vote. In each row, look at the color word, count its dots, and circle the number that matches.”

| ROW | SAY                                                                              | STUDENTS CIRCLE |
|-----|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|-----------------|
| a   | Look at the Red row. Which number tells how many dots are in Red? Circle it.     | <b>3</b>        |
| b   | Look at the Blue row. Which number tells how many dots are in Blue? Circle it.   | <b>5</b>        |
| c   | Look at the Green row. Which number tells how many dots are in Green? Circle it. | <b>4</b>        |

**PART 2 • DATA ANSWERS**

**SAY** “Look at all three rows. How many dots are there altogether? Write that number in Total. How many more dots are in Blue than Red? Write that number in More. How many fewer dots are in Green than Blue? Write that number in Less.”

- Box 1 (beside Total): **12**
- Box 2 (beside More): **2**
- Box 3 (beside Less): **1**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Circle 3 for Red, 5 for Blue, and 4 for Green. Accept 12, 2, and 1 in the three writing boxes, in that order.
