THE BIG IDEA

When you add two groups, you can switch their order. The total stays the same. Adding zero means no new items, so the total stays the same.

WORKED EXAMPLE

There are 6 yellow balloons and 2 green balloons.

Complete: $6 + 2 = 2 + \underline{\quad}$.

1. $6 + 2 = 8$.

2. Switch the groups: $2 + 6 = 8$.

3. The blank is 6.

Answer: 6
