A farmer wants to weigh a pumpkin. Name a scale that could work and tell why a ruler would not work.

#	ITEM	CATEGORY	WHY
1	A kitchen scale	SCALE	A kitchen scale measures the weight of food or ingredients.
2	A bathroom scale	SCALE	A bathroom scale measures a person's weight.
3	A ruler	OTHER	A ruler measures length, not weight.
4	A balance scale	SCALE	A balance scale compares and measures weight.
5	A thermometer	OTHER	A thermometer measures temperature, not weight.
6	A measuring cup	OTHER	A measuring cup measures liquid amount, not weight.
7	A luggage scale	SCALE	A luggage scale measures the weight of a bag.
8	A spring scale	SCALE	A spring scale measures weight by how much its spring stretches.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **SCALE:** A doctor uses a body scale to weigh a child.
- **OTHER:** A clock tells time.

Challenge: A platform scale could weigh the pumpkin. A ruler measures length, not weight.
