SPLIT EVEN NUMBERS

An even number can be split into two equal groups. You can show the groups with two equal addends.

WORKED EXAMPLE

16 buttons go into two equal cups. Write two equal addends to show the buttons in the cups.

1. Start with 16 buttons.
2. Split 16 into 2 equal cups.
3. Each cup has 8 buttons.

Answer: $16 = 8 + 8$

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **9 cards in each pile. $18 = 9 + 9$** Split 18 into 2 equal piles. Each pile has 9 cards.
2. **12 berries in each bowl. $24 = 12 + 12$** Split 24 into 2 equal bowls. Each bowl has 12 berries.

25 fish in each tank. $50 = 25 + 25$
