ORDER NUMBERS

Compare the hundreds first. If they match, compare the tens, then the ones. Start with the smallest number for least to greatest.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Order these sticker counts from least to greatest: 214, 142, 241

1. Compare the hundreds: 1, 2, 2.
2. 142 is the smallest.
3. Compare 214 and 241. 214 has fewer tens.

Answer: 142, 214, 241
