ASK TO COLLECT

A data question can be answered by asking people and counting their answers. Name the choices so each person chooses one. Ask 25 or fewer people and use 6 or fewer choices.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A class will ask 14 students about a favorite playground spot. Choices are swings, slide, and sandbox. Write a question.

1. Find what will be counted: each student's choice.
2. Name the 3 choices.
3. Ask one clear question.

Answer: Which playground spot do you like best: swings, slide, or sandbox?

4	At recess, 20 children will choose a game. Choices are tag, hopscotch, jump rope, and soccer. Write a question.	Which recess game do you want to play: tag, hopscotch, jump rope, or soccer?

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **Which book type do you want for the read-aloud: funny, animal, or mystery?** The question asks each of 18 students to choose one of 3 book types.
2. **Which snack do you want: apples, popcorn, or crackers?** The question collects one snack choice from each of 16 guests.

CHALLENGE

Which class pet would you like: a hamster, a turtle, a fish, a rabbit, or a lizard? It collects one choice from each student.

Accept any clear question that asks each person to choose one listed category. Wording may differ if the same people and choices are included.
