RELATED FACTS

Use a multiplication fact to help you recall a division fact. Multiplication puts equal groups together, and division splits a total into equal groups. The same three numbers can make related multiplication and division facts.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$7 \times 8 = \underline{\quad}$$

1. Think: 7 groups of 8.

2. $7 \times 8 = 56$.

3. Check: $56 \div 8 = 7$.

Answer: 56
