PLACE VALUE FORMS

Each digit in a six-digit number has a place value. To write expanded form, add the value of each nonzero digit. To write word form, read the number in groups of thousands.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write 482,731 in expanded form and word form.

1. The 4 is worth 400,000.
2. Write each nonzero place value:
 $400,000 + 80,000 + 2,000 + 700 + 30 + 1$.
3. Read the number from left to right in two groups: thousands, then ones.

Answer: Expanded form: $400,000 + 80,000 + 2,000 + 700 + 30 + 1$; word form: four hundred eighty-two thousand, seven hundred thirty-one
