LINE UP PLACE VALUES

Write numbers so ones, tens, hundreds, and thousands are in the same columns. Add or subtract from right to left. When a column has too many or too few, regroup with the next place value.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$4,738 + 2,586$$

1. Ones: $8 + 6 = 14$. Write 4 ones and regroup 1 ten.
2. Tens: $3 + 8 + 1 = 12$. Write 2 tens and regroup 1 hundred.
3. Hundreds: $7 + 5 + 1 = 13$. Write 3 hundreds and regroup 1 thousand.
4. Thousands: $4 + 2 + 1 = 7$. The sum is 7,324.

Answer: 7,324
