SAME VALUE, EQUAL SIGN

An equal sign means the expressions on both sides have the same value. Find the value of each expression, then write an equation that shows they are equal.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write an equation for $18 + 9$ and 3×9 .

1. Add: $18 + 9 = 27$.

2. Multiply: $3 \times 9 = 27$.

3. Both expressions have a value of 27.

Answer: $18 + 9 = 3 \times 9$

#	PROBLEM	ANSWER
1	Write an equation for $12 + 4$ and 2×8 .	$12 + 4 = 2 \times 8$
2	Write an equation for $56 / 7$ and $4 + 4$.	$56 / 7 = 4 + 4$
3	Write an equation for 11×2 and $30 - 8$.	$11 \times 2 = 30 - 8$
4	Write an equation for $63 / 7$ and $10 - 1$.	$63 / 7 = 10 - 1$
5	Write an equation for $16 + 20$ and $72 / 2$.	$16 + 20 = 72 / 2$

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. $28 / 7 = 2 \times 2$ Divide 28 by 7 to get 4. Multiply 2 by 2 to get 4, so the expressions are equal.
2. $40 - 16 = 4 \times 6$ Subtract 16 from 40 to get 24. Multiply 4 by 6 to get 24, so the expressions are equal.

CHALLENGE

$$45 - 21 = 4 \times 6 = 48 / 2$$
