PICK A UNIT THAT FITS

Think about the size of the object or distance. Use millimeters for very tiny lengths, centimeters and inches for small lengths, feet, yards, and meters for larger lengths, and miles for far distances. Choose a unit that will not make the measurement number too large or too small.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Choose the best unit to measure the length of a skateboard: millimeter, centimeter, or meter.

1. A skateboard is longer than a very small object, but much shorter than a building.
2. Millimeters would make a very large measurement number.
3. Meters are too large for this object. Centimeters fit best.

Answer: centimeter

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **yards** A school field is much longer than a few feet and much shorter than a distance measured in miles. Yards are an appropriate unit.
2. **meters** A garden is too long to measure in centimeters and far too short to measure in miles. Meters are an appropriate unit.

CHALLENGE

Guitar pick: millimeter. School to concert hall: mile. A guitar pick is very thin, while the trip to a concert hall is a far distance.

Accept singular or plural forms of each unit. For the challenge, accept another clear explanation that identifies millimeter for the guitar pick and mile for the distance.
