Use ounces and grams for objects that are light. Use pounds and kilograms for objects that are heavier. First think about the object's size, then choose the unit that makes sense.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A pumpkin has a mass of 4 kilograms. Which metric unit is appropriate?

1. A pumpkin is a heavy object.
2. Grams are used for light objects.
3. Kilograms are used for heavier objects.

Answer: kilograms

1. **grams** A tiny screw is very light. Grams are an appropriate metric unit for a light object.
2. **pounds** A full bag of soccer balls is heavy. Pounds are an appropriate U.S. Customary unit for a heavy object.

CHALLENGE

A bead: grams. A watermelon: kilograms. A sticker sheet: ounces. A large dog: pounds. Grams and ounces are for light objects, and kilograms and pounds are for heavier objects.

Accept only the named unit for each item. In the challenge, accept equivalent reasoning that clearly matches grams or ounces to lighter objects and kilograms or pounds to heavier objects.
