THE BIG IDEA

There are 16 ounces in 1 pound. To change pounds to ounces, multiply by 16. To change ounces to pounds, divide by 16.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Change 5 pounds to ounces.

1. 1 pound = 16 ounces.

2. $5 \times 16 = 80$.

3. 5 pounds = 80 ounces.

Answer: 80 ounces

Two bags for a camping trip weigh 3 pounds 14 ounces and 4 pounds 8 ounces. What is their total weight in ounces?

1. **128 ounces** Multiply 8 pounds by 16 ounces per pound. $8 \times 16 = 128$.
2. **9 pounds** Divide 144 ounces by 16 ounces per pound. $144 \div 16 = 9$.
