Track each digit's place and value in big numbers.

PLACE VALUE PATTERNS

Start at the right with the ones place. Each place you move left is worth 10 times as much as the place before it, so a digit's place tells its value.

WORKED EXAMPLE

In 482,731,965, what place is the digit 7 in? What is its value?

1. Start at the right: 5 ones, 6 tens, and 9 hundreds.
2. Continue left: 1 thousands, 3 ten-thousands, and 7 hundred-thousands.
3. Multiply 7 by 100,000 to find its value.

Answer: The 7 is in the hundred-thousands place. Its value is 700,000.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- The 6 represents 6 millions, or 6,000,000 visits.** The digit 6 is in the millions place. Multiply 6 by 1,000,000.
- The 5 is in the ten-thousands place. Its value is 50,000 points.** In 781,650,234, the 5 is in the ten-thousands place. Multiply 5 by 10,000.

CHALLENGE

The 8s are in the hundred-millions place, 800,000,000; millions place, 8,000,000; ten-thousands place, 80,000; hundreds place, 800; and ones place, 8. The values are different because each place to the left is worth 10 times as much.

Accept place names written with or without hyphens, such as ten thousands or ten-thousands. For expanded form, accept terms in any order if all nonzero place values are correct.
