PLACE VALUE TO THOUSANDTHS

A decimal point separates whole ones from parts of one. To write a decimal through thousandths, use the places for tenths, hundredths, and thousandths, even when one place has a 0.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write eight and three hundred five thousandths as a decimal.

1. Write 8 in the ones place.
2. Write 3 in tenths, 0 in hundredths, and 5 in thousandths.
3. Place the decimal point between the ones and tenths places: 8.305.

Answer: 8.305

1. **0.684** Because 684 of 1,000 equal parts are filled, write 684 in the thousandths places: 0.684.
2. **two and thirty-seven thousandths** Write the amount as 2.037, then read 037 as thirty-seven thousandths.

CHALLENGE

No. The correct decimal is 5.208. A 0 is needed in the hundredths place so that 8 stays in the thousandths place.

Accept equivalent decimal forms when the value is unchanged, such as 0.4 for 0.400, unless the item specifically names each place. Accept correctly spelled word forms with or without hyphens in compound number words.
