PLAN, SOLVE, CHECK

Line up decimal points when you add or subtract. When you multiply decimals, use the standard algorithm, then place the decimal by counting the total decimal digits in the factors. Estimate first to check whether your answer makes sense.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Find $9.4 \times 2 + 1.3$.

1. Multiply as whole numbers: $94 \times 2 = 188$.
2. Place 1 decimal digit in the product: 18.8.
3. Add: $18.8 + 1.3 = 20.1$.

Answer: 20.1

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **\$8.45** Multiply $7 \times \$1.85$ to get \$12.95. Subtract the \$4.50 coupon: $\$12.95 - \$4.50 = \$8.45$.
2. **\$7.03** The songs cost $4 \times \$1.27 = \5.08 , and the total spent is $\$5.08 + \$2.89 = \$7.97$. Subtract \$7.97 from \$15.00.

Accept equivalent decimal forms, such as 15.0 for 15. For money problems, accept answers with or without a dollar sign if the value is correct.
