CHOOSE THE RIGHT ORDER

Solve multiplication and division before addition and subtraction. Work from left to right when operations have the same priority, then finish with addition or subtraction.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$18 / 3 + 4 * 2$$

1. $18 / 3 = 6$

2. $4 * 2 = 8$

3. $6 + 8 = 14$

Answer: 14

- 6 prize bags** First find the number of prize bags: $54 \div 6 = 9$. Then subtract the 3 bags given away: $9 - 3 = 6$.
- 51 cards** Find the cards in the packs first: $5 \cdot 8 = 40$. Then add the 11 extra cards: $40 + 11 = 51$.
