CHOOSE THE ORDER

Multiply and divide before you add or subtract. When multiplication and division are side by side, work from left to right. Then add and subtract from left to right.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$14 + 6 \times 3$$

$$1. 6 \times 3 = 18$$

$$2. 14 + 18 = 32$$

Answer: 32
