UNKNOWNNS IN EQUATIONS

A blank, such as ____, can stand for an unknown quantity. Use the situation to choose an operation, then write an equation with an equals sign. Solve the equation to find the number the blank represents.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A craft kit has 31 beads. Thirteen beads are blue. Write an equation to find how many beads are not blue, then solve.

1. Let ____ be the number of beads that are not blue.
2. Write $13 + __ = 31$.
3. Subtract 13 from 31.
4. $__ = 18$.

Answer: $13 + __ = 31$; $__ = 18$

CHALLENGE

A card game has 4 equal packs with 28 cards altogether. Which equation matches the situation, $4 * \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 28$ or $\underline{\hspace{1cm}} + 4 = 28$? Solve the matching equation and explain why it fits.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- $15 + \underline{\quad} = 32$; $\underline{\quad} = 17$** The unknown is the number of points Nia still needs. Subtract 15 from 32 to get 17.
- $6 * \underline{\quad} = 42$; $\underline{\quad} = 7$** The unknown is the number of batteries in one container. Divide 42 by 6 to get 7.

CHALLENGE

$4 * \underline{\quad} = 28$; $\underline{\quad} = 7$. The cards are in 4 equal packs, so 4 times the number in each pack equals 28.

Accept equivalent equation forms when they show the same relationship, such as $\underline{\quad} + 15 = 32$. For the created word problem, accept any realistic situation in which an unknown total divided by 5 equals 3.
