USE THE FACTOR

A conversion factor tells how many of one unit equal another unit. Multiply or divide so the unit you start with changes into the unit the question asks for.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Convert 7 yards to feet. A yard equals 3 feet.

1. Start with 7 yards.
2. Multiply by 3 feet for each yard: $7 \times 3 = 21$.
3. Write the new unit, feet.

Answer: 21 feet
