MATCH THE ANGLES

Similar triangles and quadrilaterals have equal angles at matching vertices. Use the order of the letters to find matching vertices. Triangle angles total 180 degrees, and quadrilateral angles total 360 degrees.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Triangle ABC is similar to triangle DEF. Angle A = 52 degrees and angle B = 71 degrees. Find angle F.

1. Triangle ABC has 180 degrees total.
2. angle C = $180 - 52 - 71 = 57$ degrees.
3. Angle C matches angle F, so angle F = 57 degrees.

Answer: 57 degrees

- 99 degrees** Find angle D by subtracting the three known angles from the quadrilateral angle total. Angle D matches angle H.
