MOVE AND COUNT

In scientific notation, a positive exponent tells you to move the decimal point right to write a decimal. A negative exponent tells you to move it left. To write a decimal in scientific notation, move the decimal until the first number is at least 1 and less than 10, then count the moves.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write 7.36×10^3 as a decimal.

1. Start with 7.36.
2. The exponent 3 means move the decimal point 3 places right.
3. $36 \rightarrow 73.6 \rightarrow 736 \rightarrow 7,360$.

Answer: 7,360

Put these numbers in order from least to greatest: 7.08×10^{-3} , 0.00081, and 6.9×10^{-4} . Explain your reasoning.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- 256,000,000 bytes** Move the decimal point 8 places right. The file size is 256,000,000 bytes.
- 7.2×10^{-5} second** Move the decimal point 5 places right to make 7.2. Because the original decimal is smaller than 1, the exponent is negative.

CHALLENGE

$6.9 \times 10^{-4} < 0.00081 < 7.08 \times 10^{-3}$. In decimal form, the numbers are 0.00069, 0.00081, and 0.00708.

Accept equivalent scientific notation with a coefficient that is at least 1 and less than 10. Commas are optional in standard decimal answers.
