FIND THE CHANGE

Find the percentage amount by multiplying the original price by the percent written as a decimal. Subtract a discount from the original price, and add a markup, tax, or tip to the original price. For percent increase or decrease, divide the change by the original amount and multiply by 100.

WORKED EXAMPLE

An art kit costs \$72 and is discounted 30%. What is the sale price?

1. Write 30% as 0.30.
2. Find the discount: $72 \times 0.30 = 21.60$.
3. Subtract the discount: $72.00 - 21.60 = 50.40$.

Answer: \$50.40

CHALLENGE

A helmet costs \$55. A shop marks it up 20%, then takes 20% off the marked-up price. What is the final price? Is it the same as the original price? Explain using the amounts of the markup and discount.

3	Estimate, then find the sales tax and total cost for a \$64 purchase with 6.25% sales tax.	Estimate: total about \$68. Exact tax: \$4.00. Exact total: \$68.00.
4	Estimate, then find the tip and total bill for a \$28 meal with a 15% tip.	Estimate: total about \$32. Exact tip: \$4.20. Exact total: \$32.20.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- Estimate: about \$65. Exact final cost: \$64.80.** The discount is \$15, so the sale price is \$60. Sales tax is \$4.80, and the total is \$64.80.
- Estimate: about \$48. Exact total: \$48.30.** The tip is 42×0.15 , or \$6.30. Add the tip to \$42 to get \$48.30.

CHALLENGE

Final price: \$52.80. It is not the same as the original price. The markup is \$11.00, but the discount is \$13.20 because it is found from the higher marked-up price. The final price is \$2.20 lower, a 4% decrease from the original price.

Accept reasonable estimates based on rounding or benchmark percentages. Require money answers to the nearest cent and accept equivalent percent-change reasoning.
