HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and let children circle one shape in each row. Then invite each child to say the gray word while tracing it, listening for circle descriptions that use the target shape words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each shape question. Look carefully at the shapes in every row. Which shape matches the words you hear?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which shape is round and curved all the way around? Circle it.	circle
b	Which shape is round, not stretched long, and curved all the way around? Circle it.	circle
c	Which shape has a curved edge all the way around and no corners? Circle it.	circle

PART 2 • TRACE WORDS

SAY “Look at the circle beside each box. What word can you say to describe it? Say each gray word, then trace it in its box.”

- Box 1 (beside circle): **round**
- Box 2 (beside circle): **curved**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

For the three circle rows, accept the circle in each row. Accept a recognizable tracing of round and curved, and listen for the child to say either word as a description of a circle.
