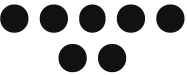

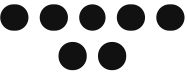

HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row aloud, then pause for students to say and circle the day word they hear in the question. In the second part, students connect a dot count to the number of days in one week.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 · FIND THE DAY

SAY "Listen as I read each row of day words. When I ask a question, say the day word, then circle it."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday. Which word says Tuesday?	Tuesday
b	Listen: Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday. Which word says Friday?	Friday
c	Listen: Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Sunday. Which word says Wednesday?	Wednesday

PART 2 · WEEK NUMBER

SAY "Count the dots in each group. A week has this many days. Can you trace the number in the first box and write the number in the second box?"

- Box 1 (beside 7 dots): **7**
- Box 2 (beside 7 dots): **7**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle Tuesday in row 1, Friday in row 2, and Wednesday in row 3. Accept a traced 7 in the first box and a recognizable written 7 in the second box.
