HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

A day name, such as Wednesday, names one part of a week. A month name, such as August, names a longer part of a year. Read each choice aloud, then have students mark the calendar word asked for.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • WEEK WORDS

SAY “Listen as I read each row. Which word names a day of the week? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which word names a day of the week: Tuesday, April, or October?	Tuesday
b	Which word names a day of the week: March, Friday, or November?	Friday
c	Which word names a day of the week: June, January, or Sunday?	Sunday

PART 2 • YEAR WORDS

SAY “Listen as I read each row. Which word names a month of the year? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which word names a month of the year: May, Thursday, or Sunday?	May
b	Which word names a month of the year: December, Tuesday, or Saturday?	December
c	Which word names a month of the year: Wednesday, July, or Friday?	July

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Week Words answers are Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday. Year Words answers are May, December, and July; accept a clear circle around the correct word.
