HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Lead children in counting aloud from 0 in order before each part. In this sheet, children keep the counting sequence going after a stopping number, then mark or write the next number they say.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • NEXT NUMBER

SAY “Count from 0 with me each time. When I stop, listen for the number that comes next and circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Count from 0 with me until I stop at 8. Which number comes next, 7, 9, or 10? Circle it.	9
b	Count from 0 with me until I stop at 36. Which number comes next, 37, 35, or 38? Circle it.	37
c	Count from 0 with me until I stop at 65. Which number comes next, 64, 67, or 66? Circle it.	66

PART 2 • WRITE NEXT

SAY “Look at the number beside each box. Count from 0 with me until I say that number. What number comes next? Write that number in the box.”

- Box 1 (beside 19): **20**
- Box 2 (beside 48): **49**
- Box 3 (beside 99): **100**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle 9, 37, and 66. Accept 20, 49, and 100 when written legibly enough to identify, and listen for children to say the next counting word after counting from 0.
