HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and pause while students count by ones aloud. Students show the number they reached by circling it or writing it in a box.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • COUNT AND CIRCLE

SAY “Will you listen to each start number, say the next four numbers aloud, and circle the last number you said?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Start at 8 and say the next four numbers aloud. Which number did you say last? I will read the choices: 11, 12, 13. Which one will you circle?	12
b	Start at 37 and say the next four numbers aloud. Which number did you say last? I will read the choices: 40, 41, 42. Which one will you circle?	41
c	Start at 96 and say the next four numbers aloud. Which number did you say last? I will read the choices: 98, 99, 100. Which one will you circle?	100

PART 2 • WRITE NEXT

SAY “Can you look at the number beside each box, say the next number aloud, and write that number in the box?”

- Box 1 (beside 29): **30**
- Box 2 (beside 58): **59**
- Box 3 (beside 99): **100**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are 12, 41, and 100. Write-box answers are 30, 59, and 100, accept readable correctly formed numerals and oral counting by ones.
