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HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to look at all the shapes before marking. Students show that shapes can be sorted into groups by matching the shape, even when the shapes are in different places.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SHAPE GROUPS

SAY “Look at each row with me. Listen to the question, look at every shape, and circle one shape for each question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which shape belongs in the triangle group? Circle it.	triangle
b	Which shape belongs in the oval group? Circle it.	oval
c	Which shape belongs in the pentagon group? Circle it.	pentagon

PART 2 • MATCH SHAPES

SAY “Look at the shapes in the left column and the shapes in the right column. Can you draw a line from each shape to the same kind of shape?”

- **circle** matches **circle**
- **square** matches **square**
- **triangle** matches **triangle**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept a circle around the triangle, oval, and pentagon in the three rows. Lines should connect circle to circle, square to square, and triangle to triangle.
