HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row aloud, including the choices, and pause for students to circle one word. Listen for students who connect a sky source with light, energy, and warming of Earth's parts.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “I will read each question and the three words in its row. Listen carefully, think about sunshine, and circle one word for each question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which word names the thing that sends Earth light and energy: LAMP, SUN, or MOON? Circle the word you choose.	SUN
b	After sunshine warms the ground on the playground, which word names what got warmer: LAND, WATER, or AIR? Circle the word you choose.	LAND
c	After sunshine warms the air outside, which word names what got warmer: WATER, AIR, or LAND? Circle the word you choose.	AIR
d	After sunshine warms a pond, which word names what got warmer: AIR, LAND, or WATER? Circle the word you choose.	WATER

PART 2 • TRACE WORDS

SAY “Now look at the gray word in each box. Can you trace over its letters with your pencil?”
