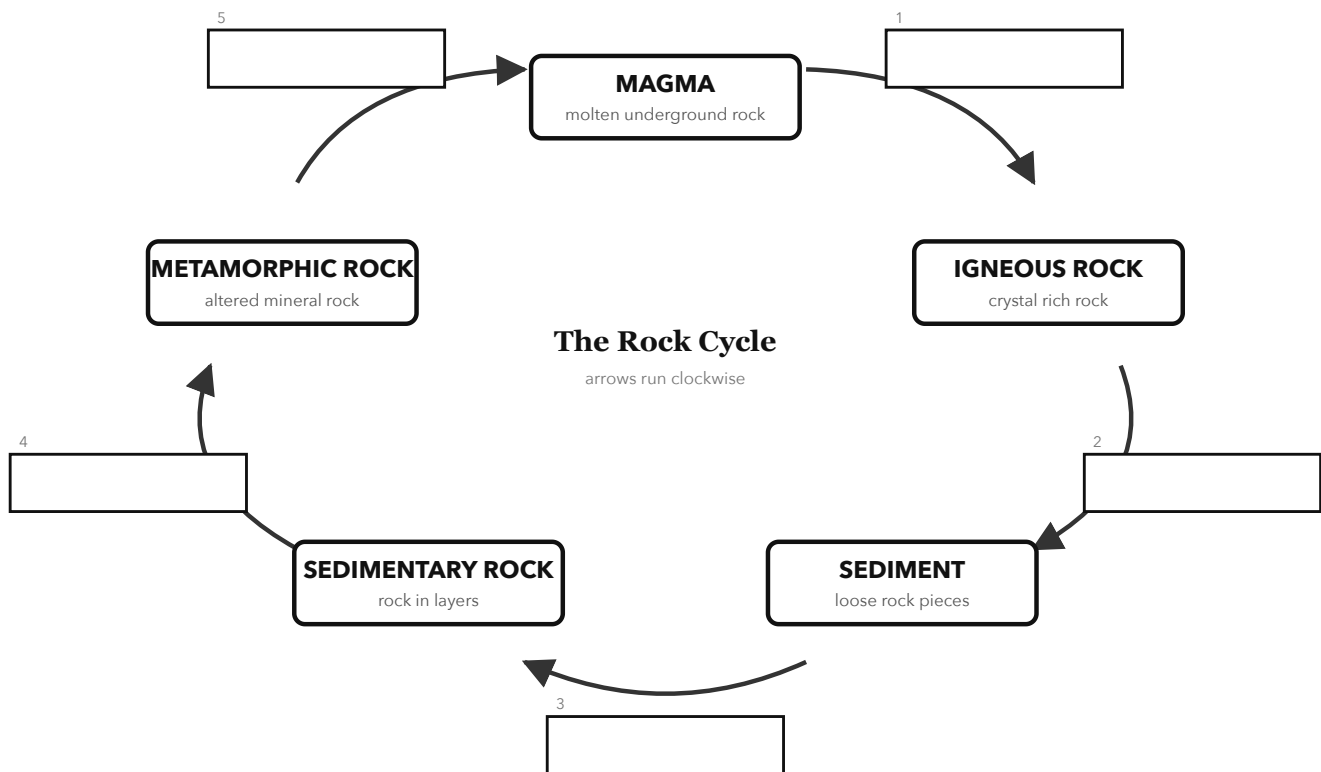

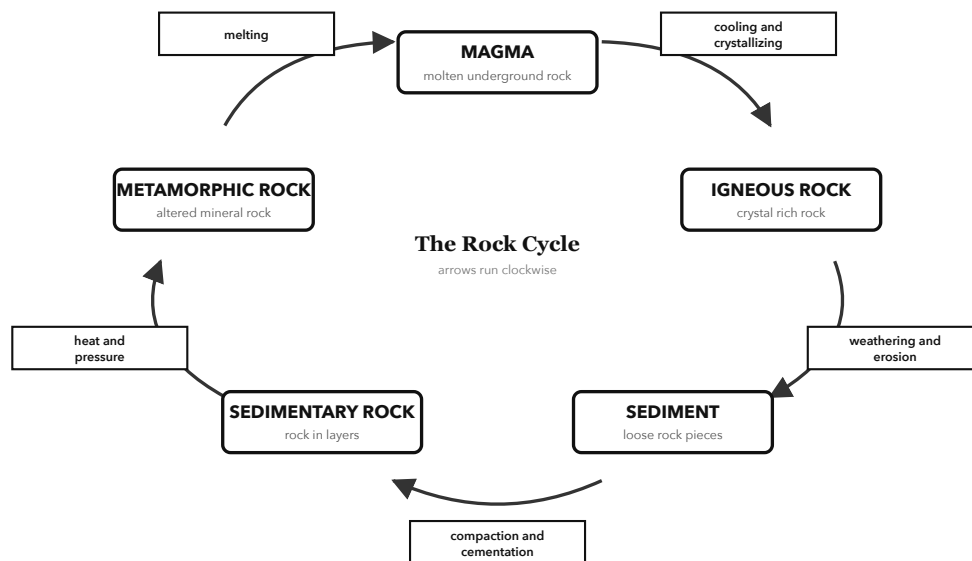

1. **Compaction and cementation.** (Which process changes sediment into sedimentary rock?)
2. **Metamorphic rock.** (What stage forms after heat and pressure?)
3. **Igneous rock, then sediment.** (Starting with magma, what are the next two stages in the model?)

TEST THE MODEL (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- It leaves out igneous rock changing directly into metamorphic rock.
- It leaves out how water, wind, and ice move sediment.

Accept only the listed process on each arrow. The model is a simplified loop, while real rocks can follow more than one pathway.
