HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row aloud and have students circle one word. Then guide students to trace the names of places where water can be found.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Water can be in many places. Listen as I read each row. Which word names a place where water is usually found? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Here are pond, book, and sock. Which word names a place where water is usually found?	pond
b	Here are chair, river, and crayon. Which word names a place where water is usually found?	river
c	Here are pencil, shoe, and ocean. Which word names a place where water is usually found?	ocean
