HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every printed word aloud before students mark the page. Students show that they can connect spoken clues about water to the words for its different phases.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH PHASES

SAY "I will read the words in both columns. Draw a line from each word on the left to the phase word on the right that matches it."

- **ice** matches **solid**
- **water** matches **liquid**
- **vapor** matches **gas**

PART 2 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "For each row, I will read the three words. Listen to the clue, then circle the word that answers the question."

a	Water in a freezer is frozen and hard. Which word names it?	ice
b	Water from a cup can be poured. Which word names it?	water
c	Which word names the water you drink?	water

WHAT TO ACCEPT
