HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use this sheet during a small-group or whole-class sink demonstration so each student can see the water move. Students observe water on a tilted hand, choose spoken words that describe what they saw, and trace two key words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • WATCH AND CIRCLE

SAY “At the sink, I will tip my hand with my fingertips lower than my wrist and let a little water move across it. Listen as I read each row, and make one circle in each row. For the last row, I will tip my hand the other way.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You heard down, up, and flat. Which word tells the way the water moved? Circle it.	DOWN
b	You heard top, low, and middle. Which word tells where the water left my hand? Circle it.	LOW
c	Now my wrist is lower than my fingertips. You heard top, middle, and low. Which word tells where the water left my hand this time? Circle it.	LOW

PART 2 • TRACE WORDS

SAY “Say each gray word with me. Trace the gray word in each box.”

- Box 1: **DOWN**
- Box 2: **LOW**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle DOWN in row 1, LOW in row 2, and LOW in row 3. Accept tracing that follows the gray models closely enough to read.
