**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Day and night are different times in a daily pattern. Read each choice aloud, then have students use sky and daily-life clues to identify and connect related words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CIRCLE IT**

**SAY** “I will read each row. Listen to the question, then circle one big word in each row. Which word fits each clue?”

**PART 2 • MATCH WORDS**

**SAY** “Look at the words on the left and on the right. I will read them to you. Which two words belong together? Draw a line from each word on the left to its match on the right.”

- **DAY** matches **LIGHT**
- **NIGHT** matches **DARK**
- **STARS** matches **NIGHT**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Circle-row answers are DAY, STARS, and SLEEP. Match DAY to LIGHT, NIGHT to DARK, and STARS to NIGHT.
